Hello,

Thanks for your inquiry about selling at Rochester Farmers Markets. We are accepting applications for the 2020 season (starting May 2020) and will continue to do so through February 28, 2020. Your seniority, if approved, will be based on the date that we receive your completed application.

Our main criteria for both outdoor and indoor Markets is that vendors are the growers of what they sell at Market, and that they reside and farm within 50 miles of Rochester, Minnesota. Baked goods are welcome if you either grow the primary ingredients (e.g. wheat, eggs, fruit, etc) or also other farm products that you grow or raise yourself.

The Board will review all new applications and we will contact you by mid-March to let you know if you have been approved. Our *permanent* vendor membership is full, and our *temporary* vendors are placed on a per-Saturday basis, in unoccupied stalls, by seniority (date of first consecutive approved application). Applications for the indoor winter market go out in September to all current RFM vendors.

Fees for 2019 (subject to change in 2020) were as follows:

- Annual membership fee: \$25
- Saturday markets: \$40 per Saturday, with a cap of \$375 for each season
- Weekday markets: \$20 per market
- Extra stall rent: \$15 per market, when available, does not apply toward cap

We host a required meeting for temporary vendors each spring to provide an overview of market rules, fees, and operations, and to answer questions you might have. Notice of that meeting will be sent along with the notice of our decision about your vendor status.

For new vendors, a farm inspection must be completed prior to selling at Market; this is considered part of the application process.
